

2nd Prize: Scholarships for Training & Sarcoma Research

Fundación Mari Paz Jiménez Casado (FMPJC) supports an annual project to promote development of sarcoma treatment and prevention measures by granting scholarships in three critical areas: Academic Training, Clinical Training, and Research.

The scholarships are funded through direct donations and fundraising events. Volunteers oversee the program.

Achievements

Below is a summary of each of the three scholarship areas and the awards granted:

Academic Training – 6 Scholarships

- 4 Scholarships for the IV Master of Sarcoma Course 2022 at the European University and GEIS.
- 1 prize for best final results in the IV Master in Sarcomas
- 1 prize for the Best exam of the XV Advanced Sarcoma Course of GEIS.
- 1 Course of Oncology Nursing in Sarcomas at H.U La FE in Valencia
- 1 Annual Fellowship in Orthopedic Oncological Surgery

Clinical Training – 4 Scholarships

6-month clinical medical rotation on sarcomas in the International Reference Center

- 2-month clinical rotation of oncology nursing in sarcomas
- 1 scholarship for International Medical Observer
- 1 clinical fellowship in orthopaedic oncological surgery

Research Training – 2 Scholarships
