FUND SARCOMA RESEARCH

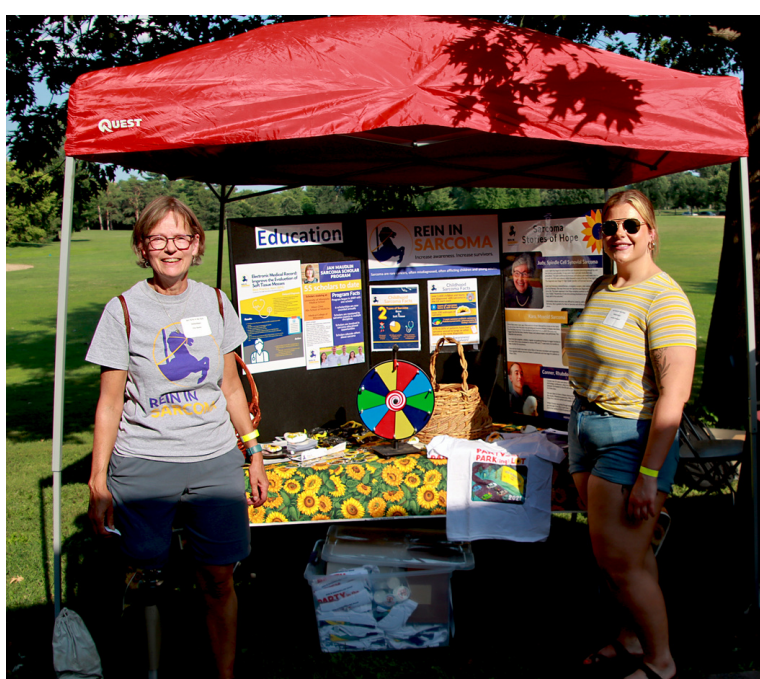
