One of our most exciting initiatives right now is a TumorGlow trial – a fluorescent imaging technology that helps surgeons find hidden tumors and achieve cleaner margins, which is one of the most critical factors in long-term survival. In addition, we are investing in efforts to educate and support our patient community – connecting families to resources, amplifying patient voices, and making sure no one faces this diagnosis without a network behind them
